Guide Tour to Ex-Sham Shui Po Service Reservoir

In June 2021, the Ex-Sham Shui Po Service Reservoir (Ex-SSPSR) was accorded a Grade 1 historical building status by the Antiquities Advisory Board. WSD has already launched a virtual tour of the service reservoir. Now we allow restricted opening of the service reservoir for visiting by the public. The visiting programme will be conducted in the form of guided tours with a view to enhance public's understanding of the historical background and appreciate the internal structure of the Ex-SSPSR, so as to increase public's awareness on conservation of historic waterworks buildings and heritage. The Guide Tour recently opens for booking. Due to overwhelming response to the application, the visiting sessions for Guide Tour between 15 Dec 2021 and 28 Feb 2022 are full at the moment.
