

World Water Day 2023 - ACCELERATING CHANGE

The theme of World Water Day 2023 is “accelerating change to solve the water and sanitation crisis”. It is hoped that the world can commit to Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 6 – the promise that everyone would have safely managed water and sanitation by 2030.

Do you know?

- Today, 1 in 4 people – 2 billion people – around the world lack safe drinking water
- Almost half of the global population – 3.6 billion people – lack safe sanitation
- 1.8 billion people use or work in health care facilities without basic water services, which means that the water supply there is more than a 30 minute walk/queue or is drawn from an unprotected source such as spring, river or pond
- Globally, 44% of household wastewater flow into nature without safely treated

Have you heard an ancient story of a Hummingbird?

One day, a fire broke out in the forest. All the animals ran for their lives.

The hummingbird was the only one who was flying back and forth to the fire, over and over again. The bigger animals asked the hummingbird what she was doing. “I am flying to the lake to get water to help put out the fire.”

The hummingbird answered. The animals laughed at her and said, “Don’t waste time, you can’t put out this fire!” The hummingbird replied, “I’m doing what I can.”

This story is about how the hummingbird reacted to a crisis. Though she was tiny, she was still willing to lend a helping hand. How about us? When we face a water and sanitation crisis, Do we stand and stare? Or Do we act?

(The story of the hummingbird originated with the Quechua people in Peru.)

“Cherish Water Campus” Water Saving Week 2023**

In order to cultivate water saving habits amongst students, WSD will organise a “Cherish Water Campus” Water Saving Week 2023 (Water Saving Week) from 15 to 19 May 2023 to encourage primary school students to participate in the activities and put their knowledge of water conservation into practice.

1. Water Saving BINGO Challenge
