### Milestones of “Cherish Water Campus”

Jun 2015

WSD started to hold “Teacher Training Workshop” towards the end of every school year to give an overview of “Cherish Water Campus” and to help teachers to plan their activities in the new school year ahead.

Sep 2015

“Cherish Water Campus” was launched and teaching kits, including activity teaching tools, CDs and worksheets were delivered to all primary schools in Hong Kong.

Representatives from WSD visited schools to introduce the programme. Inter and intra-school activities have been held by participating schools.

Jan 2016

#### “Cherish Water Campus” Pledging Ceremony

Over 300 school principals, teachers, students and guests gathered at Hong Kong Polytechnic University to form a gigantic puzzle, pledging to practise water conservation to build Hong Kong a water saving metropolis.

Feb-Jun 2016

Wide ranging water conservation activities had been carried out in schools.  
Programme reviews were received from schools.

Sep 2016

2nd year of “Cherish Water Campus” began.

Nov 2016

1st “Cherish Water Campus” Award Ceremony for 2015/16 school year: A total of 56 primary schools and 27 school sponsoring bodies were merited with group and individual awards for their outstanding performance in “Cherish Water Campus”.

Jul 2017

Up to the end of the 2016/17 school year, 227 schools had joined “Cherish Water Campus”.

3rd year of “Cherish Water Campus” began.

Smart tips for water conservation: Creepy Toilet

2 You look puzzled after going to the toilet, what’s up darling?

Umm...I’m ok. I just couldn’t find anywhere in the toilet to get my hand washed...

3 Hey, did you not notice that water was coming out from a tap above the cistern when you flushed just now, so that while refilling the cistern you could wash your hands! This "Water-Saving Toilet" can commonly be found in Japan!

4 No worries! It's hygienic for sure! With this design we can save much water by using it twice, first for hand washing, then for toilet flushing!

While this type of toilet is not that common in Hong Kong, we have "Dual-flush Cistern" which can also save water!

5 Right! There are two buttons. We should always flush with the small button when we go wee wee and the large button when we go poo poo! Water can be saved easily by flushing with the right button!
